

Cart Use Guidelines

Cart use and care:

Only use containers provided by Waste Connections of Colorado.

Bag and tie trash before placing in the cart

Clean cart when needed with soap and water

Please have trash and recycling carts out by 7:00 AM on the scheduled pick up days.

Place carts at least 2 to 3 feet apart and away from parked cars, extra trash, fences, mailboxes, or other obstructions.

Place carts in the street against the curb with the container opening facing the street.

Please do not block the sidewalk.

Unhook any temporary tie-downs that may prevent the lid from opening.

Do not place anything on top of the cart.

Do not pack waste materials too tightly into the cart.

Do not drill into, bolt, or fasten anything to the cart.

The carts are property of Waste Connections of Colorado. Do not remove the cart from the property if moving out.

Please note:

Do not place the following items in the cart.

Hazardous or prohibited waste materials, such as motor oil, tires, batteries, herbacides, pesticides, acids, ect.

Dirt, sod, rocks, bricks, concrete.

Hot ashes, coals, or other flammable materials such as solvents, oil, gas, or liquid paint. Dead animals.

Waste Connections will replace or repair carts that have been damaged from normal wear and tear. Please call customer service for repair or replacement at 303-288-2100.
