



Fall is an excellent time to continue exposing your kids to water. They had their fill of playing all summer in the pool, and now is the time to consider some formal instruction to improve water safety, stroke technique, or maybe just work on comfort level. If swim lessons are not realistic for your family's schedule, taking them to open swim times at area pools can be just as helpful. Engaging with your kids during a recreational swim can be very impactful!

Water safety tip: In 10 percent of drownings, there is an adult nearby. This may be because drowning looks different than most people assume. In real life situations, there is likely little splashing or waving or yelling. There are no calls for help. A drowning person's mouth will sink below the water and pop back up above the surface and then sink again. Their arms will be out to the side and pushing down on the water. They will not kick, and their body will be straight up and down. After about 20 to 60 seconds of this, they will begin to submerge. Remember that drownings are silent, and you have to keep your eyes on the water at all times!

Finally, as we work to expand our lifeguard team for next summer, consider lifeguard certification training this school year! The YMCA of Northern Colorado offers courses almost every month of the school year with special course offerings over winter break. 

Fall and Winter Watering

CSU Extension

Dry air, low precipitation, little soil moisture, and fluctuating temperatures are characteristics of fall and winter in many areas of Colorado. Often there is little or no snow cover to provide soil moisture from October through March. Trees, shrubs, perennials and lawns under these conditions may be damaged if they do not receive supplemental water.

The result of long, dry periods during fall and winter is injury or death to parts of plant root systems. Affected plants may appear perfectly normal and resume growth in the spring using stored food energy. Plants may be weakened and all or parts may die in late spring or summer when temperatures rise. Weakened plants also may be subject to insect and disease problems

- Water trees, shrubs, lawns, and perennials during prolonged dry fall and winter periods to prevent root damage that affects the health of the entire plant.
- Water only when air and soil temperatures are above 40 degrees F with no snow cover.
- Established large trees have a root spread equal to or greater than the height of the tree. Apply water to the most critical part of the root zone within the dripline.



PORCH LIGHTS AGLOW

The long winter nights and short winter days are upon us again. The long dark nights are the perfect opportunity for the criminal element to strike. The best way to prevent criminal activity is to keep the area well lit. If you are worried about cost, don't be too concerned. Studies show the demand is low at that time of day, so there is only a nominal cost. That makes the porch light a relatively inexpensive way to protect your valuables. There is much more expensive crime fighting equipment out there, but the police even suggest that leaving your light on is the best deterrent to a would be criminal. For the best savings, use a 40 watt, 130 volt bulb. Light also prevents accidents.



The Humble Chrysanthemum – Fall's Hardest-Working Flower

You've seen them around, these cheery little fall plants known as chrysanthemums. Often used in retail entrances and seasonal displays, you'll find them for sale at your local garden center, big box or grocery store. Their combination of intense fall colors, beautifully-rounded shapes and the plethora of non-stop blooms make the humble chrysanthemum a popular choice among homeowners and plant lovers alike.

A perennial plant in warmer climates, the chrysanthemum will come back each year and bloom again. However, the hard winters and low temperatures in Colorado most often require us to treat this plant as an annual (though in the right spot, the plant might just return for a repeat performance next year). This helps explain why so many of the beauties we see are displayed in baskets and pots rather than planted in garden beds.

Just when the blooms of our favorite summer flowers begin to fade away, chrysanthemums are here to fill that void. They are the perfect transitional plant between seasons. Even in November, it is not too late to add chrysanthemums to your outdoor fall décor. Chrysanthemums tend to prefer cooler weather, so load up on this fall favorite.

For a quick and easy display method, simply place the plants in pots or baskets, put alongside wreaths, gourds, and pumpkins, or other fall decorations, and set out on your porch or patio for a glorious fall arrangement. If these plants are kept in a somewhat sheltered area and Coloradans are rewarded with a mild autumn and late frosts this year, you may be able to enjoy chrysanthemums for several weeks to come.

When you purchase a chrysanthemum, it is likely already in full bloom. This means the plant is pretty much at its peak and the flowering will not last too much longer. Look for healthy plants with mostly unopened buds to prolong their bloom time and your enjoyment. As lovely as the chrysanthemum is, in Colorado it is often treated as another seasonal decoration which can get tossed or composted when the holidays are over.

Did you know that chrysanthemums, or "mums" as many people call them, are actually members of the daisy family of plants? They are related to marigolds, dahlias, and cosmos, among others. If you look more closely at a chrysanthemum, you'll see why — they share many of the same characteristics: stems are soft, not woody; petals are flat or curled; leaves are pointed; and what many consider to be individual flowers are really complex flower heads--generously packed with smaller florets into rounded pom-poms or the more familiar "daisy" petals-and-eye form.

Chrysanthemums come in a wide variety of colors, including the traditional red, yellow, white and purple. However, we also see chrysanthemums that are pink, lavender or multicolored, along with the fall spectrum of hues – from creamy whites and golden yellows, to bright ambers and oranges, and to deep magentas and bronzes – there is something for everyone!

Add some cheer to your outdoor fall décor! See what is available at a local store or garden center today. The chrysanthemum will not let you down.
