

1. What items CAN NOT be recycled?

Please DO NOT place the following products in your curbside recycling container. NO GARBAGE | NO PLASTIC BAGS | NO PLASTIC FILM | NO STYROFOAM®

- NO PLASTIC BAGS OR FILM: We cannot accept plastic bags in your curbside recycling bin. Plastic bags can be recycled at most local grocery stores.
- NO NON-RECYCLABLE PLASTICS: We accept plastics #1-7 but there are some plastics that are not recyclable. These products include Styrofoam, hard plastic items including toys, plastic chairs, flower pots, PVC pipes and any other plastic products that are not listed in these guidelines.
- NO LIQUIDS OR FOOD RESIDUE: Please completely empty and rinse out all containers before recycling.
- NO CERAMICS OR OTHER GLASS PRODUCTS: Do not place glass, ceramics, china, dishes, mirrors, light bulbs, Pyrex, porcelain, or window glass in your curbside
- NO SCRAP METAL: No scrap metal items of any size in your curbside recycling
- NO ELECTRONICS: Do not place electronic devices in your curbside recycling
- NO HAZARDOUS WASTE: We do not accept hazardous waste such as oil-based paint, automotive fluids, car batteries, fertilizers or pesticides. Latex paint recycling locations can be found on PaintCare.org.


Your Home Helper

Planting Trees in Spring

Did you know that spring is a great time to plant trees? That's right! When the weather is cooler, the ground is warming, and it's not too hot outside, is the perfect time to get your trees started.



What Kind of Tree Should I Plant?

You may have heard that in Colorado, fall is the best time to plant trees, and in many cases that's right. However, that doesn't mean that spring isn't still a good time to plant a tree! The trick is to plant the tree when it's ready to grow in the soil in your area and to make sure it doesn't dry out in what is often a long, hot summer. Choose locally grown trees when possible, to ensure they're best acclimated to our climate. Many trees are shipped here from the southern USA, and these will need plenty of babying before they're ready to perform for you in our dry air and intense sunshine.



How to Plant Your Tree

Planting trees may sound as easy as digging a hole and plopping your tree in. You can do that, but you wouldn't be setting your tree up for success! Planting your tree comes down to three key steps. First, dig yourself a hole, but not just any kind of hole. Dig out a dish shape that extends about 2-3 feet from the "root ball" of your tree. The dish should be about 1 inch shallower than

the height of your root ball. Make sure the root flare, where the trunk begins to widen as it meets the soil, is visible—this should rest an inch above the final grade. The hole should slope downward toward the center, and finish up with what we call a "donut." This donut is a ring of soil directly in the center on which you can place the root ball of your tree. This type of hole allows your tree to grow long-extending roots, rather than circling roots that can be promoted by a narrow hole.

Second, place your tree on the donut in the center of your hole, and fill the hole with soil. There's no need to amend the soil in the hole; in fact, this can hurt the tree's growth in the long run. Don't forget to cover the soil with mulch. Mulch is great for keeping unwanted weeds and other pests from bothering your tree as it gets established and for keeping the root ball moist. Make sure to leave at least a three-inch space between your mulch and the tree trunk. A layer of mulch four inches deep will suppress weeds.

Last, water! When you're working to get a tree established, water is essential. I usually recommend watering your trees every other day, and even more during hot periods. Getting a tree established is a long process, but it's worth it! If the soil in the top inch or so of the root ball of the tree is dry, water it!

When I was growing up, my family bought over 20 small pine trees to water across our yard, and we didn't do any of these things! We planted in the middle of summer, didn't dig the hole properly, planted on the sides of a hill, and didn't use any mulch. Guess how many survived? Two. Make sure you don't treat your trees the way that we did, and set your trees up for a long healthy life!

- If you rent a property and your rental lease has expired since the end of the last season you will need to reapply.
- If your cell phone number has changed and you need to update your VIZpin so that it is tied to the new number, simply email us at registration@stonegatenorthvillages.org. Include your name, address, and your date of birth if you are under the age of 18 and include a note about your new cell

number. We will confirm when it is updated and then you can simply download the app on your new device.

- If a household member has turned 18 and would like access to the adult pool and spa, please send an email to registration@stonegatenorthvillages.com.
- All adults in the pool and spa facility require their own VIZpin Mobile Access Pass (Smartkey). Failure to have a valid VIZpin Mobile Access Pass (Smartkey) will result in the loss of facility access.
