Native Grass Conversions

Due to the limited amount of reclaimed water for the irrigation system, the District is continuing to convert the bluegrass turf to native grass. The areas of bluegrass being converted have been carefully selected to blend in with native areas within and around the District. Doing this will reduce the amount of water necessary to irrigate the native areas by at least 33%. In addition, the District will have more reclaimed irrigation water available to continue keeping the bluegrass green and healthy.

Native conversion this year is along the south side of Lincoln between Chambers and the Stonegate/Lincoln south entrance. In Filing 21 it's a smaller area next to Riverstone Dr. The other area will be along the west side of Jordan Rd going north of Stonegate Pkwy. The Town of Parker is going to install a new sidewalk from Village Center Dr south to Stonegate Pkwy. Since the plans have not been finalized, we're not sure exactly where the native area will be located quite yet.

The available irrigation water is getting low. With the heat streak and receiving less natural moisture, the turf in the District will be watered less than in years past. Without the native conversions the District will not have enough irrigation water to keep the bluegrass green and healthy throughout the season as it has been in the past.

New Fencing Reminder

Please keep in mind that the perimeter fence is solely owned and maintained by The Stonegate Village Metro District. The District does not allow any homeowner to attach personal items such as trellises, lighting or any other items to either the interior (homeowner side) or exterior (common area) side of the fence. You could be held responsible for repairs to restore the fence back to original condition.

Reservoir Notice

We have had an increase in individuals trespassing at the Reservoir located off Stonegate Parkway (referred to as the Retention Pond). To protect the District's property and the health, safety and welfare of the District's residents, taxpayers and constituents, the District does not allow fishing or watersports on any District property, including but not limited to the District Reservoir. We have asked Douglas County Sheriff department to patrol the area and ticket trespassers. If you see anyone trespassing, we ask that you call the Douglas County Sherriff non-emergency line at 303-660-7505. We greatly appreciate your assistance in this matter.

General Reminders

Sign up for autopay as it is convenient and free. Also sign up for email bills only. Both save resources! Call the District Office for assistance. The tennis court code is on every bill and this code changes randomly (south side). Look for a new code in August. An explanation of charges is conveniently located on the back of every paper bill.

Complaint Procedure

Who May Submit Complaints? Complaints regarding alleged violations of the Covenants, Design Guidelines or Rules and Regulations may be reported by members of the Board of Directors, members of the Community or the Association's Manager.

How Complaints Should Be Submitted. Complaints by a member of the community shall be in writing and must include a contact name and email address or phone number in case there is an inquiry from the Board or management office regarding the complaint submitted. Anonymous complaints will not be accepted. Your name and contact information will not be provided to the person you have made a complaint about; it is only needed for the management team. The member must have observed the alleged violation and shall contain the nature of the alleged violation, the location of the alleged violation and the date it was observed. Photos are very helpful. A complaint may also be submitted by any member of the Board of Directors or by the Association Manager after a walk through or inspection of the Community. Trash Receptacle Reminder

Please remember to secure your lids on your trash cans properly and make sure plastic bags are tied when left for the disposal carrier. On those windy days, your neighbors would prefer not having your trash all over their front yard. Also as a reminder, trash bags/receptacles should not be stored outside of the home prior to trash pick-up day. It is also helpful if you bag your trash items and place the bags in the receptacles rather than throwing loose trash into the bins. Modifications Committee (MC)

In order to try to improve the current homeowner design review request submittal procedure, our MC has established a process for the receipt, review and response of all future design review requests. The MC will schedule and convene meetings as necessary to review homeowner applications submitted to the management company, PCMS, based upon the following schedule: a) owner applications with all required additional documentation received by the first Friday of the month will be reviewed by the MC for response to the owner by the third Friday of the month; b) owner applications with all required additional documentation received by the third Friday of the month will be reviewed by the MC for response to the owner by the first Friday of the month. RECYCLING GUIDELINES

For the health and safety of our workers, please make sure all recyclable materials in your curbside bins are washed out and clean and follow the below guidelines.

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING ITEMS

1. What items CAN be recycled?

Paper

mixed paper | cardboard newspapers, magazines, & catalogs cartons | paperboard phonebooks & paperback books

Metals

aluminum cans | foil pie plates | steel cans loose metal jar lids | bottle caps

Plastics

rigid plastic | bottles and containers plastics #1-7, No food residue, plastic bags, Styrofoam or hard plastic items

Glass

Clean and washed-out glass containers including bottles, jars, etc. No food residue

- Empty and rinse all containers
- Place recyclables loose and unbagged in your recycling container
- Flatten all cardboard and paperboard boxes
- Place your recycling container 4ft from parked cars and other obstacles

1. What items CAN NOT be recycled?

Please DO NOT place the following products in your curbside recycling container.

NO GARBAGE | NO PLASTIC BAGS | NO PLASTIC FILM | NO STYROFOAM®

- NO PLASTIC BAGS OR FILM: We cannot accept plastic bags in your curbside recycling bin. Plastic bags can be recycled at most local grocery stores.
- NO NON-RECYCLABLE PLASTICS: We accept plastics #1-7 but there are some plastics that are not recyclable. These products include Styrofoam, hard plastic items including toys, plastic chairs, flower pots, PVC pipes and any other plastic products that are not listed in these guidelines.
- NO LIQUIDS OR FOOD RESIDUE: Please completely empty and rinse out all containers before recycling.
- NO CERAMICS OR OTHER GLASS PRODUCTS: Do not place glass, ceramics, china, dishes, mirrors, light bulbs, Pyrex, porcelain, or window glass in your curbside recycling container.
- NO SCRAP METAL: No scrap metal items of any size in your curbside recycling container.
- NO ELECTRONICS: Do not place electronic devices in your curbside recycling container.
- NO HAZARDOUS WASTE: We do not accept hazardous waste such as oil-based paint, automotive fluids, car batteries, fertilizers or pesticides. Latex paint recycling locations can be found on PaintCare.org.

Your Home Helper

We receive many questions about homes, updating, real estate and more. Our goal with this monthly column is to address commonly asked questions in Stonegate. Please send your questions to Dan@SouthDenverDigs.com.

Question: What home maintenance tasks should I be doing now to keep my home in top shape?

Answer: At the risk of being a buzzkill, winter is just around the corner. We will be complaining about the cold soon enough. If you are a procrastinator like me, you will be blowing out your sprinklers as the first snow is falling. August is a great time to get ahead of the winter prepping while the weather is still nice.

- Trim your dead tree and shrub branches. All Douglas County residents can recycle tree waste for free and get some free mulch in return. Google "Douglas County slash mulch program."
- Checkyour roof. Most roofers will give you a free inspection of your roof. Most of our roofs have been replaced in the last few years, but small damage can happen at any time. Call the roofer that replaced your roof or call us for a referral.
- Now is a great time for an energy audit. Xcel Energy will give you a rebate for a portion of these inspections. Check on their website or call 1-800-895-4999.
- Replace all your worn-out door and window seals. Most seals are easily replaced and readily available online or in big box stores. It is easier than you think. YouTube can help.
- Refinish your deck. Snow is hard on the wood on decks the moisture will get in the cracks and freeze. It is much easier to refinish now than in January!
- Clean out your gutters. We know you will have to do it again soon, but you have a much better chance of keeping them flowing and preventing leaks if they are clean before the leaves start falling. Check the flow of any underground drains.

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Some (new?) plants to enjoy!

"Ooh, what is that!?" Finding a "new to you" plant in someone else's garden can be exhilarating. Color, shape, texture, and presence all contribute to the effect the new plant has on your senses. I am always on the lookout for new things to grow and I wanted to share some plants that were new to me, at least! Each year's growing conditions (growing extremes!) provide an opportunity to find something new for your garden.

First up is blue flax (Linum lewisii). A Colorado native that is easily procured at a garden center or grown yourself. I found the seeds at my local feed store. If the ethereal movement of a tall grass that sways in the garden is appealing to you, but with flowers, then this is THE plant. Each day in spring, a new tiny blue (actual blue!) flower opens going up the stem and sways in the garden, providing movement and flow. Birds use the seeds in the fall and winter too. https://gilpin.extension.colostate.edu/programs/mtn-hort/blue-flax/

Next up is pineapple mint (Mentha suaveolens 'Variegata'), a fabulous filler. Stay with me here. Mint can be a weed as it spreads readily but this variegated white and green mint is a stunner. Use it in summer drinks or wait until it gets tall and use it in arrangements. The smell and taste of this mint is delicate and delicious. Mint can also be used as a living mulch under trees and in beds where dry shade reigns. No need to haul expensive bags of mulch for a beautiful and surprising look.

Everyone has heard of, or at least seen, Autumn Joy Sedum (Hylotelephium 'Herbstfreude') but there are so many other varieties to choose from. I have a small full-sun sedum patch where I grow 8 different kinds of sedum. I love Blue Spruce sedum (Sedum sediforme) because they look like 3-inch evergreen trees, or try Old Man Bones sedum (Sedum globosum) which is self-descriptive. A dark leaf sedum provides surprise interest. Best of all, once established they don't need any supplemental water. They tend to bloom in autumn when the annuals are slowing down, and pollinators of all kinds love them. To propagate sedum, break off a piece of stem and stick it in the ground. The flowers come in pink, red, maroon, and yellow and they range in size between ground cover and a few feet tall.

Finally, a vining plant. There are many fun vining annuals, so try something new each year: including black-eyed susan vine (Thunbergia alata), firecracker vine (Ipomoea lobata), or ruby moon hyacinth bean (Lablab purpureus). My personal favorite is cypress vine (Ipomoea quamoclit). Hummingbirds and butterflies love the red trumpet starshaped flowers. I love the fine soft fern-like foliage. It is delicate and really reminds me of a cypress tree frond. All these can be direct sown from seeds. If you do want to start with plants, buy them early, because it can be a real challenge to disentangle them from the nursery tray.

Petunias, hostas, and geraniums all have their place in the garden but so do more unique plants. Dare to be rare!


