

Please list on your application all permanent household members planning to visit the SVMD South Pool. Only one email address per household is required. The **Mobile ePass is FREE** or you can order an **optional physical ID card for \$5 each**. Kids under 10 years old will not be issued a pool pass and will need a parent with them to enter the pool. But we suggest you list all kids on your application while you're at it, and we'll take their photo someday in the future when they are old enough for their own ePass or ID Card.

There is no need to wait for a confirmation email! After you submit your application, please proceed to SVMD's office (address above) for photo(s). Adults, please bring to the photo session either a government-issued ID, driver's license, or a utility bill that includes your name and Stonegate address. Thinking of a buffalograss lawn? Consider these three things first.

Installing low-water lawn alternatives is all the rage in Colorado right now, and one popular choice is buffalograss. This native Colorado species can make a good lawn substitute in some places, but it isn't without drawbacks—so consider carefully if it's the right fit for you.

- 1. Buffalograss isn't green a lot of the time. Buffalograss is a warm-season or C4 species (because of a molecule it uses in photosynthesis with 4 carbon atoms, not because of any explosive tendencies). Warm-season grasses are dormant for much of the year in Colorado—generally until night temperatures are reliably above 50 degrees. In the eastern half of the state, it will be green mid-May through September. Bluegrass, by comparison, is usually green March-November (or longer).
- 2. Buffalograss won't tolerate shade. Do you have a nice big tree in the yard? Then buffalograss probably isn't a good option; it needs full sun to grow best. A shaded buffalograss lawn will quickly become thin and patchy—a condition that is usually closely followed by extreme weediness. For shady spots, consider fine fescue (a cool-season species), another droughttolerant lawn species that does well in shade, shade-tolerant ground covers, or even wood chip mulch.
- 3. Buffalograss doesn't care for traffic. Buffalograss can tolerate light recreation and foot traffic-you could even play croquet on a wellestablished buffalograss lawn. But if you have pets and/or children who will be using the lawn a lot, buffalograss will disappear (searching for greener pastures?). Fellow warmseason bermudagrass and cool season species Kentucky bluegrass and perennial ryegrass are more traffic-tolerant options.

If you start your buffalograss lawn from seed, the best-seeded cultivars are: Sundancer, Bison, Bowie, Cody, and Topgun. You can also plant buffalograss from plugs–Legacy and Prestige are the most cold-hardy for Colorado winters.

Whatever type of grass you choose for a lawn, remember that lawns don't waste water, people do. Make sure that your sprinkler system is in good repair, with no crooked or broken heads. Water should spray on the lawn, not on the sidewalk, the house, or other impervious surfaces. Match your water use to the season and only water when the grass needs it, not on the same schedule from May to October.

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

Complaint Procedure

Who May Submit Complaints? Complaints regarding alleged violations of the Covenants, Design Guidelines or Rules and Regulations may be reported by members of the Board of Directors, members of the Community or the Association's Manager.

How Complaints Should Be Submitted; Complaints by a member of the community shall be in writing and must include a contact name and email address or phone number in case there is an inquiry from the Board or management office regarding the complaint submitted. Anonymous complaints will not be accepted. Your name and contact information will not be provided to the person you have made a complaint about; it is only needed for the management team. The member must have observed the alleged violation and shall contain the nature of the alleged violation, the location of the alleged violation and the date it was observed. Photos are very helpful. A complaint may also be submitted by any member of the Board of Directors or by the Association Manager after a walk through or inspection of the Community. Planning a Pool Party?

Learn more about holding events at the Family Pool

Suntan lotion, pizzas, juice boxes and a birthday cake along with a gaggle of young kids — pool parties are a hallmark of summertime. Interested in planning a pool party? **Here are the things to know:**

• The Family Pool is available for pool parties across the summer season. The cost of the facility is set at \$50 per/hour.

• Lifeguard costs are separate. The cost is \$40per/hour/ per lifeguard, based on number of people. If the pool party is held during normal pool hours, one guard is required per 25 people. 1 to 25 people requires a per/hour charge for one guard. 26 to 50 people requires a per/hour charge for two guards. If the pool party is held outside of normal pool hours, a minimum per/hour charge for two lifeguards is required regardless of the number of people.

• Times available for pool parties: Sunday: After pool hours from 8 p.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Thursday: During regular pool hours or after pool hours from 8 p.m. to 10 p.m. Friday and Saturday: After pool hours or from 8 p.m. to 10 p.m.

• The pool can't be rented for exclusive use except for parties held outside of normal working hours.

• Anything over 5 guests is considered a pool party. So, while residents may use some of their allotted guest passes for visitors, if you plan on having more than 5 guests with you, it is important you note this is considered a party and you must utilize the reservation system.

• All reservations need to be made through the district's online scheduling tool and are subject to both the District's Recreational Rules and Regulations as well as the District Rental Policies.
