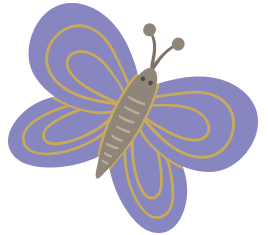

If you are looking for an affordable and fun summer activity for your children, look no further! The SRA Swim Team is a Recreational Summer Swim Team that swims out of the Anthology and Stroh Ranch HOA Neighborhoods.

Non-residents are allowed to join the team, but residents get priority.

We teach youth swimmers (ages 6 - 18) how to swim technical strokes (Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Butterfly) and compete in swim meets.

Swimmers need to be able to swim at least one of these strokes 25 yards (one length of a pool) to join the swim team.

The swim team season runs from Tuesday, May 27th to Saturday, July 19th

We practice four days a week and swim meets on Saturday mornings.

Guest Policy: Guests are permitted at the rec center. 2 guests per household at no charge. \$3 fee per each additional guest up to a maximum of 5 guests per day. Payment by credit card only.

Weight Room Etiquette: Residents, please respect our homeowner's policy that no children under the age of 13 years are to be in or using the weight room. All children 13 to 17 years of age must be accompanied by an adult resident if they have not done a youth orientation. Any questions please see the front desk.

Youth Orientation: Teens ages 13 to 17 are eligible to use the Recreation Center unaccompanied only after attending Youth Orientation. Email katie@frontrangerecreation.com to schedule an orientation. Complaint Procedure

Thinking of a buffalograss lawn? Consider these three things first.

Installing low-water lawn alternatives is all the rage in Colorado right now, and one popular choice is buffalograss. This native Colorado species can make a good lawn substitute in some places, but it isn't without drawbacks—so consider carefully if it's the right fit for you.

1. Buffalograss isn't green a lot of the time. Buffalograss is a warm-season or C4 species (because of a molecule it uses in photosynthesis with 4 carbon atoms, not because of any explosive tendencies). Warm-season grasses are dormant for much of the year in Colorado—generally until night temperatures are reliably above 50 degrees. In the eastern half of the state, it will be green mid-May through September. Bluegrass, by comparison, is usually green March-November (or longer).
2. Buffalograss won't tolerate shade. Do you have a nice big tree in the yard? Then buffalograss probably isn't a good option; it needs full sun to grow best. A shaded buffalograss lawn will quickly become thin and patchy—a condition that is usually closely followed by extreme weediness. For shady spots, consider fine fescue (a cool-season species), another drought-tolerant lawn species that does well in shade, shade-tolerant ground covers, or even wood chip mulch.
3. Buffalograss doesn't care for traffic. Buffalograss can tolerate light recreation and foot traffic—you could even play croquet on a well-established buffalograss lawn. But if you have pets and/or children who will be using the lawn a lot, buffalograss will disappear (searching for greener pastures?). Fellow warm-season bermudagrass and cool season species Kentucky bluegrass and perennial ryegrass are more traffic-tolerant options.

If you start your buffalograss lawn from seed, the best-seeded cultivars are: Sundancer, Bison, Bowie, Cody, and Topgun. You can also plant buffalograss from plugs—Legacy and Prestige are the most cold-hardy for Colorado winters.

Whatever type of grass you choose for a lawn, remember that lawns don't waste water, people do. Make sure that your sprinkler system is in good repair, with no crooked or broken heads. Water should spray on the lawn, not on the sidewalk, the house, or other impervious surfaces. Match your water use to the season and only water when the grass needs it, not on the same schedule from May to October.

- Place your recycling container 4ft from parked cars and other obstacles

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: What items CAN be recycled?

Paper: mixed paper | newspapers, magazines, catalogs | cardboard | cartons | paperboard | phonebooks & paperback books

Plastics: Clean and rinsed out rigid plastic bottles and containers | No food residue No plastic bags | No Styrofoam | No hard plastic items

Metals: aluminum cans, foil, pie plates | steel cans | loose metal jar lids & bottle caps

Glass: Clean and washed out glass in your curbside recycling bin | No food residue

NOT ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: What items CAN NOT be recycled?

NO GARBAGE | NO STYROFOAM® | NO ELECTRONICS | NO SCRAP METAL

NO PLASTIC BAGS OR FILM: We cannot accept plastic bags. Plastic bags can be recycled at most local grocery stores.

NO NON-RECYCLABLE PLASTICS: We accept plastics #1-7. Some plastics that are not recyclable: Styrofoam, hard plastic items including toys, plastic chairs, flower pots, PVC pipes & any other plastics that are not listed in these guidelines.

NO LIQUIDS OR FOOD RESIDUE: Please completely empty and rinse out all containers.

NO CERAMICS OR OTHER GLASS PRODUCTS: Do not place glass, ceramics, china, dishes, mirrors, light bulbs, Pyrex, porcelain, or window glass in your recycling container.

NO HAZARDOUS WASTE: No hazardous waste such as oil-based paint, automotive fluids, car batteries, fertilizers or pesticides. Latex paint recycling locations can be found on PaintCare.org.
